Task: Evaluate the credibility of an image through a reverse image search.

Instructions:

1. If you are unfamiliar with lateral reading (using the internet to check the internet), watch this [Retro Report video](#).
2. Then, respond to the guiding tasks and questions in the EAS/SEA strategy below to evaluate either an image provided by your teacher or an image that you have come across in your research.

“EAS” into the image. Reverse image search. Then “SEA” the image.

	Guiding task/question	Your Response
Explain	Explain what you see in the image.	
Ask	Write out at least three questions that you have about the image.	
Source	Note what you know about the source of the image & its credibility.	
REVERSE (paste the image into a Google image search and respond to the questions below)		
Source(s)	Review the results of your search- what do the initial collection of sources show you? Select a source that seems reliable to dive deeper.	
Ask	What does this source tell you about the image & its credibility?	
Explain	Explain whether or not this image is credible & why or why not.
