

# 5 Ways to Weave lilyPD into Your School's PD Ecosystem



## Self-Paced Learning

- Offer a curated menu of lilyPD courses and invite teachers to select a learning path aligned to their professional goals.
- Share lilyPD access during new teacher onboarding so it becomes part of your welcome toolkit.
- Build in regular check-ins (e.g., a brief reflection, a conversation) to keep momentum going.



## Workshops

- Use lilyPD modules as the “pre-work” component and design your workshop around discussion and planning.
- Ask teachers to implement one strategy, reflecting on what worked and what to change going forward.
- Create a workshop follow-up plan that points teachers back to specific lilyPD resources.



## PLCs

- Choose one lilyPD module as “pre-work” for each PLC cycle.
- Use PLC time to share classroom attempts and reflect on what worked and what to change next time.
- Build in student work analysis tied to strategies from the course.



## Department Meetings

- Build a rotating “lilyPD moment” into your department meeting agenda.
- Let department members take turns choosing the module and leading the discussion.
- Track strategies that have been implemented across the department and celebrate what's working.



## Instructional Coaching

- Coaches preview lilyPD content and identify modules aligned to teacher goals.
- Assign a targeted module as part of the pre-conference preparation.
- Reference lilyPD strategies explicitly during observations and debriefs.
