Exhibit Entry Point		
	The exhibition has a specific, clear, unique title that alludes to the exhibit's topic.	
	The exhibit entry point has a central image that connects to the title and topic of the exhibit.	
	The exhibition overview has a clear, central claim that responds to the exhibit's central question.	
	The exhibition overview fully summarizes the topic of the exhibition in detail and analyzes how the topic connects to the larger historical narrative of the time. It explains how the objects in the exhibit connect to the exhibit's topic.	



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Museum (Object/Artifact) Labels		
	Each object directly connects to the exhibit's topic and/or time period.	
	Each object label is 150 words or less.	
	Each label has a title and a date.	
	Each label begins with a description of what the object is. This description provides details about the object itself, leaving the reader with no questions about what the object is.	
	Each label explains how the object connects to the topic of the exhibit and how the object supports the central claim.	
	Each label cites a source for where the object is from along with any sources that were used to write the label.
